The Penetrator omnidirectional base antenna

General Description

The Penetrator is a full size 5/8-wave, omnidirectional antenna. It features a full sized radiator with lower radiation angle concentrating power closer to the ground. The antenna is designed to accept AM, FM, SSB, and DSB signals. This model can be fed by any standard 52-ohm coaxial cable, such as RG-8/u and RG-58/u. For runs over 50 ft., RG-8/u is recommended.

The Penetrator is designed to fit any masting material up to 1-5/8" O.D. A 1-1/4" plumbers pipe is highly recommended for mast use due to its low cost and high strength.

Installation Instructions

Unpack the antenna and check each part against the parts list.


() Select the base	assembly (item 12), the two radial plates (item 1), the M
assembly (item 13),	and the upper insulator (item 11).	

() Refer to Figure 1 and loosely assemble these parts as shown, using the $1/4^{\prime\prime}$ x $1^{\prime\prime}$ screws and associated hardware. Do not tighten at this time.

NOTE: Make certain the end with 1/4" diameter holes, located 3/8" from the end, are down and align with the holes in the insulator. Also remember to point the two smaller holes, located 5-5/8" and 13" from the bottom end, away from the base bracket, as these will later be used to attach the matching rod assembly.

() Fasten the M1 assembly to the i	nsulator with the	$#10 \times 1-3/4"$	screw (item 26
and associated hardware (item 41 a	nd <mark>35). Tight</mark> en se	curely.	

- () Referring to Figure 2, assemble the 7/8" x 25" R1 tubes (item 3) into the brackets, aligning the holes and fastening with 1/4" x 1-1/2" screws, nuts, and lockwashers (items 24, 34, and 40).
- () Tighten the $1/4^{\prime\prime\prime}$ x $1^{\prime\prime\prime}$ screws holding the base brackets and radial plates.
- () Remove the two rod support insulators (item 21) and the two #10 x 5/8" screw (item 29) and #10 internal lockwasher (item 41) from the parts pack and attach as shown in Figure 3 to the M1 assembly.



() Attach the matching rod and beta rod exactly as shown in Figure 3.

() Assembly the radiator tubes M2, M3, M4, and the top radial assembly, also the radial elements, by following Figure 4.

It must also be noted that when assembling the various tubes in either the radiator or the radials, the tubing must be slipped inside the larger tubing until the black mark disappears. This is important for proper operation of the antenna.

- () Assemble the top hat radials as shown in Figure 5. They should be spaced 90 degrees apart.
- () Attach the four $1/8^{\prime\prime}$ caplugs on the end of the top hat radials and the $7/16^{\prime\prime}$ caplugs on the end of the R3 tubes.
- () Check all hardware and tighten securely.
- () Loosely assemble the 5/16" U-bolts on the bracket as shown in Figure 3.
- () Mount on the top of your mast and tighten the U-bolts securely.
- () Attach your coax to the connector, located on the bottom of the base bracket and hook to your transceiver.
- () This completes your installation.


